No.S&GAD/A-16(71)2021(Gazetted-I): The Governing Body of Azad Jammu & Kashmir Medical Colleges, on the recommendations of Selection and Recruitment Committee, has been pleased to accord approval for appointment of **Maj. Gen. (Retired) Prof. Dr. Abdul Khaliq Naveed** as Principal, Azad Jammu & Kashmir Medical College, Muzaffarabad on contract basis by relaxing Rule 19(1) of the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Civil Servants (Appointment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 1977 as per following terms & conditions:

1. Pay Package:

Description	Amount (Rs.)
Basic Pay:	2,40,000/-
House Rent:	1,05,000/-
Utilities:	12,000/-
Medical Teaching Allowance (30%):	72,000/-
Total	4,29,000/-

2. Facilities:

a.	One Chauffeur Driven Car maintained at Institution's expense for official and private use:	5 Door Standard Pajero or equivalent, or car of 1300/1600cc capacity.
b.	Petrol Limit:	200 liter per month.
c.	T.A/D.A on domestic duty:	As admissible to civil servants of highest grades.
d.	T.A/D.A on official duty:	As admissible to civil servants in Category-I.
e.	Medical Facilities:	Reimbursement Medical and Hospitalization charges for self, spouse and children for treatment received at Government or Government recognized institutions in AJ&K and Pakistan.
f.	Gratuity:	One month's pay for each completed year of contract.

3. Medical Facilities:

The incumbent shall have to appear before the Competent Medical Authority/Board for medical examination and shall join the service on having declared medically fit.

4. Tenure:

The appointment will be purely temporary on contract basis, initially for a term of 03 years, from the date of assumption of charge. The period of contract is further extendable subject to satisfactory performance & good conduct to be evaluated by the appointing authority.

5. Pension:

The service rendered under the present contract shall not be qualify for pension, General Provident Fund or Group Insurance and Benevolent Fund.

6. Leaves:

During the contract, the incumbent will be entitled to avail leaves as per prevailing rules and regulations.

- a. 24 (Twenty-Four) casual leaves per annum, as per Casual Leave Rules, 1983 shall be admissible.
- b. Earned leave shall be admissible as per Revised Leave Rules, 1983.

7. Performance/Evaluation:

The performance of the incumbent shall be assessed/evaluated regularly on the basis of efficiency and conduct during the contract period by the performance evaluation board.
